## Search Engines

### [100s Scholarships Mil Kids](#)

User-friendly descriptions and links to many scholarships. Some are branch-specific or for children of disabled/deceased service members.

### [Military Scholar](#)

Large search engine that will provide scholarship suggestions based on your answers to 12 filtering questions.

## Scholarships for children of service members or Veterans who are disabled, deceased, MIA, or POW (lowest % VA disability rating that qualifies)

### [Survivors' and Dependents' Ed Asst-100%](#)

VA Ch. 35 benefit for children of a Veteran/service member who qualify. It provides a monthly payment to help cover the costs of education/training for up to 36 months.

### [FL Scholarship Disabled Vet-100%](#)

For children of disabled/deceased Veterans who are/were Florida residents. Provides the cost of in-state tuition and is paid directly to the school. **Complete FFAA by April 1** for priority consideration.

### [Heroes' Legacy Scholarship-100%](#)

A merit-based scholarship that may be used to pay for qualified expenses (tuition, fees, labs, books). Must have 3.0 GPA and application includes an essay. **Deadline February 17, 2022.**

### [Freedom Alliance Scholarship Fund-100%](#)

Scholarship may be used to cover any costs incurred while pursuing higher education (i.e., tuition, books, housing, meal plan, and transportation). **Apply AFTER April 15.**

### [American Legion Legacy - 50%](#)

A needs-based scholarship that provides up to \$20,000 in aid for undergraduate or post-grad college. **Apply between January 1 and April 15.**

### [Folds of Honor-10% Dis or Purple Heart](#)

Scholarships of up to \$5,000/year to cover unmet needs (tuition, fees, dorms, meal plans, books). Must have 2.0 GPA. **Apply between February 1 and March 31.**

### [Patriot Legacy Fund- 10%](#)

Scholarships are based on need as supported by the Expected Family Contribution from the FAFSA. Funds are sent directly to the school and can be applied toward tuition, fees, books, supplies, and on-campus room and board. Must have 2.5 GPA.
