Program Overview

Mission

Beginning with the 2020 Patriot Baseball season, the Pace High Baseball Booster Club will begin a new program called the "Patriot Diamond Girls". The purpose of this new program is to expand upon the work already being performed by the Pace High Booster Club and to help build awareness and support for the baseball program.

Guidelines

The program will be open to Pace High School students currently in grades 9-12. The program will consist of approximately 16 students. The plan is for 4 students selected from each grade level, 9th grade students will support the Freshman Team, 10th grade students will support the JV team, and 11th and 12th grade students will support the Varsity team. Students will not be required to attend all home games as scheduling for each game will be performed by the program manager. However, please refer to the schedule below and make sure that you are generally available to attend home games before applying for the program. In addition to attending home games, students will be required to attend a meeting with the program manager before the season to discuss roles, responsibilities, and scheduling. Pace High Baseball Boosters Club is 100% running this program this is NOT affiliated with the Pace High School staff or administration. This program is to help promote and support the baseball program with community services hours given.

Roles and Responsibilities

Below are examples of some of the tasks that students selected for the program will be asked to perform as part of supporting the Pace High baseball program.

- Concessions
 - There will always be an adult on duty in the concession stand with students in order to perform/supervise more hazardous tasks such as cooking with fryers or the grill.
 - The Diamond girls will help prepare drinks and snacks while waiting on concession stand patrons.
- Spirt Wear
 - Students may be asked to work the spirt wear table for the purpose of selling, advertising, and promoting Pace High baseball related spirt wear.
 - Students may be asked to make signs to create awareness at school of home games.
- Fundraising Work
 - Students may be asked to assist and/or attend fundraisers for the baseball team.

Benefits and Perks

Below are examples of some of the benefits that students selected for the program will receive due to their help supporting the Pace High baseball program.

- Community Service Hours
 - Students selected to be a Patriot Diamond Girl will receive community service hours for their time helping to support the Pace High Baseball program.
- Diamond Girl Gear
 - Patriot Diamond Girls will receive a diamond girl shirt to wear while volunteering.
- Season Pass
 - Each Diamond Girl will receive their own pass to get into the home games.

Please complete the attached application and return it to the Athletic Office no later than Friday, December 13th. Once applications have been reviewed, the selected candidates will be contacted by one of the program managers and may require a face to face interview.
